In the event that a candidate for an officer role is unsuccessful they may still be elected as a Trustee, in which case circle both the officer role they are being nominated for AND Trustee

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> The Branch Committee may comprise a maximum of 11 Trustees (including the officers). If the Branch votes to have a Vice-Chairman, there will be 4 officers and therefore the Branch may vote for up to 7 Trustees (general committee members)

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> The Candidate must be willing to accept the role and responsibilities of being a charity trustee. Further details are set out in the "Letter to potential branch committee members" produced by the Association
